Requirements

- › Be a minimum of 14 years of age
- › Have parental permission if under 18 years of age
- › Provide consent for a background check
- › Submit annual tuberculosis test
- › Participate in an annual orientation
- › Wear hospital uniform and ID badge at all times while on campus
